

TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

INTRODUCTION:

This agreement details the transferability of courses from the A.A. or the A.S. programs at Edison State Community College to the Bachelors of Business Administration degree program at the College of Business Administration.

PROGRAM COVERED:

Students from Edison State Community College completing the A.A. or A.S. who are admitted to the College of Business Administration may pursue the BBA degree in the concentrations listed in the current College of Business Administration Bulletin. Edison State Community College students who plan to opt for Information Systems as their Focus Concentration upon transferring to the College of Business Administration are not required to take a General Education Science Elective at the University of Cincinnati, and the available number of Non-Business Elective hour will change from nine hours to three hours. To replace these hours Information Systems majors will complete CIT 222S and 223S at Edison State Community College.

This agreement is **not** designed to articulate with the Bachelor of Science in Industrial Management. Students transferring into this program will have their credits assessed on an individual basis.

A course equivalency table is attached which details how courses from Edison State Community College will transfer to the College of Business Administration.

ADMISSION INTO THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION:

The College of Business Administration is a selective admissions college of the University of Cincinnati. Acceptance by the College of Business Administration is dependent on such factors as the number of spaces available and the number of and quality of the transfer applicants. Edison State Community College will advise all potential transfer students that admission is highly competitive and that they should strive to exceed the minimum standard for consideration. Meeting the minimum standard does not guarantee acceptance into the College of Business Administration. Edison State Community College and the College of Business Administration will advise students that they should complete the Associate's degree before transferring to the College of Business Administration.

The admissions standards for Edison State Community College students who apply to transfer to the College of Business Administration are a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.50 from all colleges attended and successful completion (earned at least a D grade, with an A.A. or C without an A.A.) of College Algebra (Math 122S) and Calculus for Business and Life Sciences (Math 226S) in order to be considered for admission. The College of Business Administration will guarantee admission to Edison State Community College students who complete the Associate's degree and who have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00 from all colleges attended.

An Edison State Community College student who successfully transfers and matriculates in the College of Business Administration will be subject to the academic policies and curriculum as stated in the College of Business Administration Bulletin in effect at the time of matriculation.

GRANTING OF JUNIOR STATUS:

All courses successfully completed at Edison State Community College will transfer to the College of Business Administration as detailed in the attached course equivalency table. Students who have completed the Associate's degree in Pre-Business and who have been admitted to the College of Business Administration will be considered to have junior class rank upon completion of 91 quarter university credit hours.
