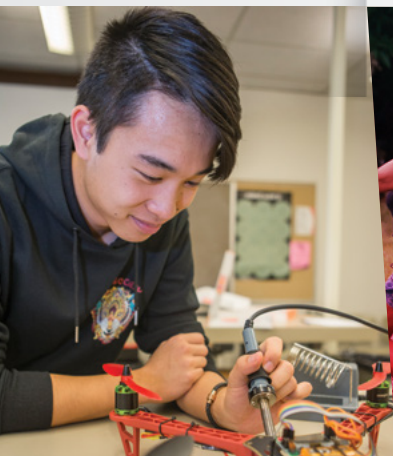

First-Year Student Deadline Information

December 1 – Early Action (non-binding)

First-year applicants who wish to be considered for **scholarships** and the **honors program** must complete their application by December 1.

Students applying to the following colleges should also complete their application by the Early Action deadline (applications received after December 1 will be considered on a space-available basis):

- Lindner College of Business
- College–Conservatory of Music*
- College of Design, Architecture, Art, and Planning
- College of Engineering and Applied Science
- College of Medicine
- College of Nursing

March 1 – Rolling Admission (fall)

First-year applicants submitting a complete application by March 1 will receive full consideration for admission to a baccalaureate program. Applications received after this date will be reviewed on a space-available basis.

Test-Optional for 2021 & 2022

UC has chosen to make ACT and SAT test scores optional for students applying to most programs for the fall 2021 and fall 2022 terms to ensure equitable opportunity for admission. Read more at:

Indiana and Kentucky students

To recognize the proximity of students from these neighboring states, Cincinnati offers Indiana and Kentucky students two special tuition rates:

Metropolitan Rate: Available to students from Kentucky and nine Indiana counties. Tuition is Ohio-resident rate plus \$25/credit hour (maximum \$300/semester).

Reciprocity Rate: Residents of 28 Indiana counties and some residents of eight Kentucky counties may enroll at the Ohio-resident rate.
