

March 1 - Rolling Admission (fall)

First-year applicants submitting a complete application by March 1 will receive full consideration for admission to a baccalaureate program. Applications received after this date will be reviewed on a space-available basis.

Indiana and Kentucky students

To recognize the proximity of students from these neighboring states, Cincinnati offers Indiana and Kentucky students two special tuition rates:

Metropolitan Rate: Available to students from Kentucky and nine Indiana counties. Tuition is Ohioresident rate plus \$25/credit hour (maximum \$300/ semester).

Reciprocity Rate: Residents of 28 Indiana counties and some residents of eight Kentucky counties may enroll at the Ohio-resident rate.
