COOPERATIVE EDUCATION

UC created co-op learning over 100 years ago to help students make the transition from school to work while receiving academic credit by combining classroom-based education with practical work experience. Students graduate with up to 1.5 years of real-world experience!

Our innovation paid off. Today, 100% of UC students are participating in experiential learning, regardless of campus. However, only some programs require co-op.

Students in co-op programs will alternate academic semesters with semesters spent working full-time in their chosen field, while receiving a salary.

To date, UC co-op students have collectively earned \$75 million during their program duration.

DIRECT ADMIT TO MAJOR SELECTED

Students are admitted directly into a major – there is no secondary application. If a student is not admitted to their first choice major, we review for other fit programs which includes academic programs at our regional campuses.

TEST OPTIONAL

University of Cincinnati is test optional. The only program that will require a standardized test score is the Bachelor of Science in Nursing. Students are reviewed based on the entirety of their application, not just GPA and a test score.

PRIORITY APPLICATION

The priority application deadline is December 1.

This includes the deadline to be reviewed for the University
Honors Program and merit-based scholarships. The UC
College Conservatory of Music has different deadline dates.

Cincinnati Decision Day is held in January of each year
for students who apply to UC by December 1!

ROLLING ADMISSION

The rolling admissions deadline is March 1, but some programs will close on December 1. We encourage applicants to complete their application by December 1.


