Introduction: This agreement details the <u>applicability</u> of courses from the Cuyahoga Community College Associate of Applied Business in Paralegal Studies degree to the Bachelor of Science in Law & Paralegal Studies degree in the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services. Students who complete the Associate of Applied Business in Paralegal Studies degree at Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) have partially satisfied the UC Law & Paralegal Studies General Education requirement.

Articulation Overview: Graduates from Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) who have followed the prescribed program and are accepted into the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services will enter with 60 hours of transfer credit applicable toward the Bachelor of Science in Paralegal Studies degree.

Admission Criteria: Please note: completing the courses on the Transfer Degree Map below does not guarantee admission to the UC Bachelor of Science in Law & Paralegal Studies degree program.

Minimum GPA: 2.5

BS Completion: Completion of this program may require more than four semesters to complete due to prerequisite requirements and the order in which required courses must be taken and are offered. UC academic advising staff will work with each transfer student to develop the most expedient pathway to graduation.

Admission Period: Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) students must be admitted to the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services during the duration of this agreement (i.e. between December 2023 and July 31, 2026).

Agreement Execution Date: December 2023

Agreement End Date: July 31, 2026

EXECUTION, DURATION AND REVIEW OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement becomes effective upon its approval of both institutions and will remain effective for the duration of the <u>Transfer Pathways Completion Articulation Agreement</u> (Institutional Agreement). At the end of this time, the Transfer Degree Map will be reviewed and may be renegotiated. Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) and the UC College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services agree to keep one another informed as program changes affecting the agreement occur and will be reviewed on an annual basis and is subject to change due to revisions in program curriculum or ABA-approved status. Both Colleges will agree upon any future additions and/or amendments to this document in writing.

As strong partners, Cuyahoga Community College Paralegal Studies program agrees to provide direct access to students in the last semester of their degree program to a University of Cincinnati representative **upon request when possible**. This could be in the form of a classroom visit or other opportunities to directly interact and educate students about the program at the University of Cincinnati. Cuyahoga Community College Paralegal Studies program also agrees to provide a graduation list with email addresses **upon request when possible**. The University of Cincinnati College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services will provide success rates of incoming cohorts of Cuyahoga Community College Paralegal Studies students upon request as able.

Cuyahoga Community College students are encouraged to work closely with their academic advisor to monitor possible changes.
