 - o Hold credentials as an occupational therapy assistant as certified by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy; conditional acceptance is granted into the program for those who are eligible to take the OTA exam and have a plan in place to complete the exam.
 - Complete a UC application, including submission of official transcripts from all institutions attended.
 *Note: UC application fee for the BS: Health Sciences Pre-Occupational Therapy program will be waived for San Juan College students who have completed the AAS OTA program, for any admission term, through the calendar date marking the end of the Fall 2023 semester at UC. This waiver will be renegotiated after this period.
 - o Pay UC's matriculation fee.
- Students must be admitted to the UC College of Allied Health Sciences during the duration of this agreement.
- Minimum GPA: 2.50
