Degree requirement for UC Clermont:

Admission Requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education

(Courses in parentheses are UC Clermont course equivalents)

- A minimum overall GPA of 2.75
- A minimum grade of "B" in CMST 101 (COMM 1071) and ENG 102 (ENGL 2089)
- A minimum grade of "C" in all other pre-admission courses and required EDU and EDS courses which include EDU 300 (PSYC 2040), EDU 305 (EDST 1001), EDU 313 (CI 1001), and EDS 360 (SPED 1001).
- Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators: Reading (5712) 156 or higher, Writing (5722) 162 or higher and Mathematics (5732) 150 or higher
- Pass criminal background check
- 61 semester hours completed
- An acceptable portfolio
- A completed application to the Teacher Education program

Degree requirements for a Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education:

Students majoring in Elementary Education must maintain a GPA of 2.75 overall in major courses in order to enroll in the clinical experience. Students must earn a minimum of 120 credit hours and at least 45 credit hours must be 300 level or above. Students must meet the pre-requisites for each course. At least 20 percent of the total required hours must be taken at NKU.
